Travelling from Sydney Airport



Sydney Airport is located 8km from the city centre and the best way into town is the train - taking you to Circular Quay in around 20 minutes.



Train to City: \$17*



Taxi to City: \$45+



If you are going to use a mixture of buses, trains, ferries and light rail, you should load your money onto a free Opal card - it works out cheaper and is very convenient.






Opal Card - For Use on bus, trains, ferries and light rail.

- We have outside communal BBQs everywhere on the beach so you can cook your own food
- Visit the Botanical Gardens it's free, in the heart of the city and a great place for a run
- Check out the 'I'm Free Tours' 2 free walking tours of Sydney taking in the sights and history of Sydney and The Rocks
- Visit the Glebe markets on a Saturday for everything from arts & crafts to delicious foodie treats
- Dollar Dogs at The Soda factory \$1 hot dogs in a cool bar on Tuesdays (Cheapskate Tuesday!)
- Get the ferry to Watsons Bay for Doyle's fish and chips
- Do the Bondi to Coogee walk (approx.6km) or Manly to the Spit (approx.10km) - both beautiful walks
- You can eat a Kangaroo or Crocodile pizza at The Australian for approx. \$25 if you fancy some exotic Australian pub grub

Shopping

Tips from the locals

- Sporting fan or not, we recommend watching a sporting match at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) or booking a tour of Melbourne's most famous sporting arena.
- Visit the Block Arcade Melbourne, the most famous shopping and cafe precinct. You'll be blown away with the hidden secrets found in the arcade.
- Eat at the first travelling Tram Restaurant in the world The Colonial Tramcar Restaurant.
- Visit Mornington Peninsula it's an hour away from Melbourne CBD and has wineries, beaches, national parks. It's also home to one of Victoria's most famous day spas, the Peninsula Hot springs.
- Go from ground level to 285 metres above in 38 seconds with the Eureka Sky deck- the fastest elevator trip in the Southern Hemisphere and then enjoy the view!
- Visit Lygon Street and discover Little Italy the place where Melbourne's famous cafe culture was born. But be prepared...you may get offered free wine or garlic bread to have with your dinner, so don't just stop at the first place!

Shopping

With fashion-forward boutiques, elegant arcades and buzzing shopping centers, Melbourne is one of Australia's best shopping destinations.

Travelling from Gold Coast Airport



Gold Coast Airport (formally known as Coolangatta) is 'just over the road' from the beach and is about 25km from Surfers Paradise. Trains and buses operate from the airport.
