Auckland Airport is the largest and busiest airport in New Zealand, located about 20km from the city centre. It takes about 45 minutes to an hour to get between the city centre and the airport by bus so make sure you leave enough time!

Wellington Airport is about 5km from the city centre and the Airport Flyer Bus service runs at least once every 20 minutes, going to the Hutt Valley, through the city centre and on to Queensgate.


Tipping

If you're looking

to explore more of New Zealand, consider hiring a car to see the amazing cities and landscapes.

The 92km voyage takes 3 hours and has been described as "one of the most beautiful ferry rides in the world".

There are 3 or 4 ferries in either direction each day - check out **interislander.co.nz** for timetable info.





Auckland Local Tips



- Get the ferry to Waiheke Island and visit the wineries there, it's a beautiful spot overlooking the water.
- Go to the top of the Sky Tower and walk on the glass over the city! Not for those who are scared of heights!
- If you see 'The Food Truck' be sure to stop for a bit to eat - it's a celebrity chef selling his delicious food!
- Visit Ponsonby for great cafés, restaurants and boutique NZ designer stores.

Wellington Local Tips

- Visiting Te Papa Museum is a must... not to mention it is free general admission.
- Take a wander around the waterfront to Oriental bay. The waterfront is beautiful and is dotted with cafés, bars, parks and sculptures.
- For a nice walk and to take in some of the best views of the city, head up Mount Victoria where you will get a 360' view of the city.
- Did you like the The Lord of the Rings movies? Head to Weta Cave to take a behind the scenes look!



Christchurch Local Tips



- Visit the Botanic Gardens and see why Christchurch is called the Garden city. It's free and highly recommended, plus there is also a museum which showcases NZ history.
- Riccarton Markets are on every Sunday, where a lot of locals go to pick up their fresh produce.
- Victoria Park in the Port Hills is a nice place to visit for walking or cycling tracks with great views over Christchurch.

Queenstown Local Tips

- If you love food you've got to go to Fergburger, open 24/7 it's not often you see this place without a bit of a line.
- Take the gondola up the mountain for spectacular views of Queenstown, then take the luge back down again.
- The lake is beautiful from all angles, but for an up close look, you can hire a kayak and paddle across it.
- Visit Cow known for incredible Pizza.
