English is commonly used throughout Qatar. But Arabic is the official language. Here are some useful Arabic phrases for your trip:

Thank you	شكراً	Shukran
Goodbye	مع السلامة	Ma'assalaama
Sorry	آسف	Aasif
Yes	نعم	Na'am
No	ע	Laa
How much does this cost?	کم سِعر هذا؟	Kam si'r haadha?
Can you speak in English?	هل تتكلّم إنجليزي؟	Hal tatakallam ingiliizi?
Do you have an English menu?	هل عندك قائمة طعام بالإنجليزي؟	Hal 'indak qaa'imat ta'aam bil-ingiliizi?
Can I have the bill please?	مُمكن الفاتورة من فضلك؟	Mumkin al-fatuura min fadlik?
Where is the toilet please?	أين الحمّام من فضلك؟	Ayna al-hammaam min fadlik?

Money Tips

Travel Tips

Currency

The currency in Qatar is the Qatari Riyal (QAR). It is denoted by the symbol ن.ق

One riyal is equal to 100 dirhams (like our pounds and pence).

Denominations

Banknotes come in: 1 (green), 5 (grey/orange), 10 (blue), 50 (red), 100 (turquoise), 200 (red/orange) and 500 (purple) riyals denominations.

Coins come in 1, 5, 10, 25 and 50 dirham denominations.

Tipping

If no tip is included, 10% - 15% is appreciated.

Cash and cards usage

Cards and cash are widely accepted within the larger stores. However, small or local stores and market stalls will generally only take cash, particularly in the Sougs.

ATMS

ATMs are located in major shopping malls, some Sougs, hotels and on the street.

General tips

- Alcohol is available in Qatar, but only on licensed premises such as larger hotels, hotel restaurants and specific fan zones.
- Restaurants, cafes and museums don't open until 1 or 2pm on Fridays. Friday prayers, or Salat al-Jumu'ah, are an important event for Islam worldwide, and adhered to by many in Qatar.
- Qatar's official religion is Islam, so dress is generally conservative. Shoulders and knees are expected to be covered in public, but rules are more relaxed inside international hotels, resorts, bars and nightclubs.
